AIRPORT RELEASES APRIL'S STATISTICS

(Spokane, WA) – Spokane International Airport (GEG) reported that during the month of April, 128,936 passengers boarded planes; a 5.63 percent increase versus April of 2006's 122,066. Through the first four months of 2007, GEG has handled 1,035,116 total passengers; a 4.20 percent increase over 2006's 993,387.

During the month of April, 4,311.5 tons of freight and mail came through GEG in comparison to 4,746.5 tons in 2006; a 9.16 percent decrease. Through April of 2007, 17,423.7 tons of total cargo has come through GEG in comparison to 19,066.0 tons in 2006; an 8.61 percent decrease.

Felts Field Airport's 6,778 aviation operations during April were a 32.56 percent increase from 2006's 5,113. For 2007, 19,160 aviation operations have been reported at Felts Field; a 4.10 percent increase versus 2006's 18,406. Felts Field also reported 3.3 tons of freight was handled during April; a 62.92 percent decrease over 2006's 8.9 tons. Through April 2007, 18.3 tons of freight has been reported at Felts Field; a 26.80 percent decrease from 2006's 25.0 tons.
