## **AIRPORT RELEASES AUGUST'S STATISTICS**

(Spokane, WA) – Spokane International Airport (GEG) reported that during the month of August, 170,957 passengers boarded planes; a 12.53 percent increase versus August of 2006's 151,919. August was also the fourth consecutive month for double-digit growth of enplaned passengers. Through the first eight months of 2007, GEG has handled 2,315,524 total passengers; an 8.28 percent increase over 2006's 2,138,475.

During the month of August, 4,841.6 tons of freight and mail came through GEG in comparison to 5,273.4 tons in 2006; an 8.19 percent decrease. Through August of 2007, 33,652.0 tons of total cargo has come through GEG in comparison to 38,739.0 tons in 2006; a 13.13 percent decrease.

Felts Field Airport's 9,235 aviation operations during August was an 18.98 percent increase from 2006's 7,762. For 2007, 49,697 aviation operations have been reported at Felts Field; a 6.49 percent increase versus 2006's 46,669. Felts Field also reported that 6.2 tons of freight was handled during August; a 24.00 percent increase over 2006's 5.0 tons. Through August 2007, 43.0 tons of freight has been reported at Felts Field; a 21.82 percent decrease from 2006's 55.0 tons.
